Dear Parents & Carers,

The School Fees for **2020** have been established and there is a small increase.

School fees consist of four components: Tuition Fee, Resource Fee, Technology Fee and Building Levy.

The **Tuition Fee** represents a small proportion of the actual costs involved in staffing and operating a school. This fee is discounted for siblings.

The **Resource Fee** is an annual amount charged in Term One. It represents a partial contribution towards student school materials, stationery and other consumables. The school will be providing all materials for the students in the classrooms including writing materials. There is no sibling discount for this fee – all students are billed \$265.00.

Technology Fee an annual amount of \$80 per child to upgrade and maintain our technology/hardware.

Building and Maintenance Levy is \$280 *per family*. Partial contribution toward the cost of major maintenance and the service of capital loans.

The payment methods are: **EFTPOS: CASH: CHEQUE: BPAY** – use the **Biller Code** and **Reference** printed on your statement.

Families receive a **5% discount on tuition fees if the total annual 2020 school fees are received by 13th March**. The discount will be issued via a fee credit to your school account. You must pay the *Annual Total* up front to receive the 5% credit
